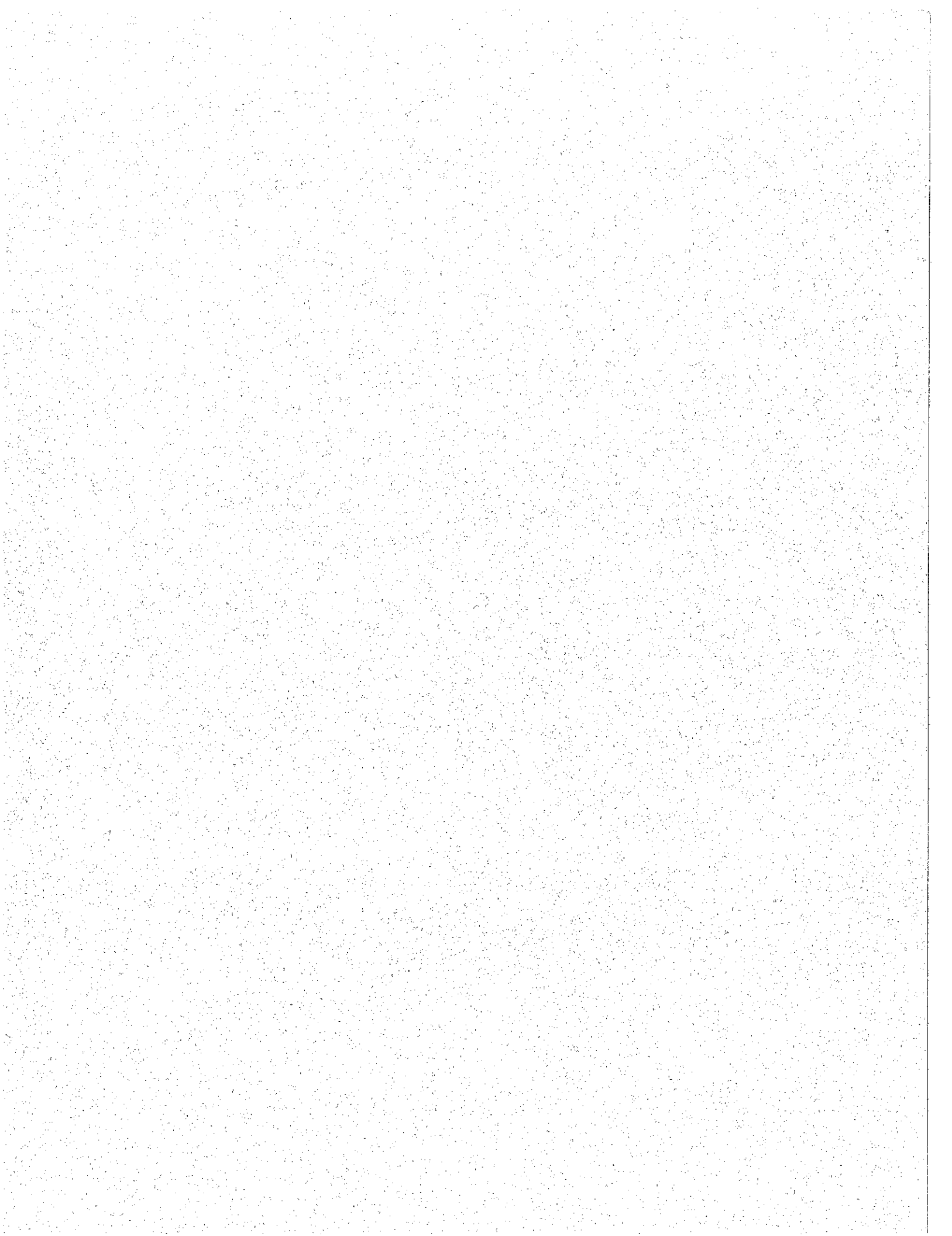

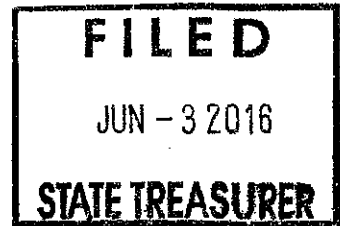

**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION**

**FOR**

**BELLMAWR LEARNING COMMUNITY PARENT TEACHER ORGANIZATION,**

**a New Jersey Non-Profit Corporation**

**THE UNDERSIGNED**, all of whom are citizens of the United States, desiring to form a Non-Profit Corporation under the Non-Profit Corporation Law of the State of New Jersey, Title 15A of the New Jersey Statutes annotated, do hereby certify:

**FIRST:** The name of the Corporation shall be **BELLMAWR LEARNING COMMUNITY PARENT TEACHER ORGANIZATION, a New Jersey Non Profit Corporation.**

**SECOND:** The place in this state where the principal office of the Corporation is to be located in the Township of Gloucester, County of Camden, and State of New Jersey, specifically 1250 Chews Landing Road, Suite 1, Laurel Springs, New Jersey 08021.

**THIRD:** Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) and the granting of scholarships.

**FOURTH:** The Corporation is a membership organization. Membership, eligibility and class of membership shall be determined in accordance with the By-Laws of the Corporation.

**FIFTH:** The names and addresses of the persons who are the initial Trustees of the corporation are as follows:

The Corporation shall have no less than five (5) Trustees at any time.

**SIXTH:** No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Third hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence litigation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not vary on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision

of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

**SEVENTH:** The existence of the corporation shall begin upon the filing of the Articles of Incorporation, and thereafter, is to exist perpetually.

**EIGHTH:** The office of the Registered Agent and address is Leonard J. Wood, Esquire, 1250 Chews Landing Road, Laurel Springs, New Jersey 08021.

**NINTH:** Upon dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Trustees shall, after paying or making provisions for payment of all liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such a manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Trustees shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the court of competent jurisdiction in New Jersey to an organization operated exclusively for such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine which are organized or operated exclusively for such exempt purposes.

**TENTH:** The method of electing Trustees shall be set forth in the By-Laws of the corporation.


